Greetings Campbell Band Family!

It is time for Band Camp! I am happy to join Mr. Smith for an exciting year with the Spartan Bands. Thank you for your patience as we have sorted out the schedule and facilities. Campbell High School is under major renovations, so we are being flexible during camp to offer you the best experience.

❖ **What is the schedule for camp?**

We are making some minor adjustments for SLT (Student Leadership Training) camp and keeping it exactly the same as in the rough draft for full camp.

SLT Camp:

Wednesday, July 14 and Thursday, July 15, 9 AM – 4:30 PM (no Friday SLT camp as planned – facilities are unavailable) – Please bring lunch and plan to remain on campus. Also, please bring instruments & music and be prepared to play both days.

***Color Guard** Pre-Season Camp will take place on Wednesday, July 14th. **Drum Line** Pre-Season Camp will take place on Thursday, July 15th. All leaders should be present both days.*

Wednesday morning, we will begin by moving all equipment needed for camp from the CHS Band Room to Smyrna Elementary School. Please meet behind Smyrna Elementary School on the bus lot by the U-Haul truck and we will proceed from there. Anyone who is available and willing to help would be welcomed and appreciated.

Full Band Camp:

- Monday, July 19 – Friday, July 23: 9 AM – 8 PM
Monday morning, July 19, check-in will be behind Smyrna Elementary School from 8:30 – 9:00 AM. (See attached map.)

❖ What do I need to do to prepare for camp?

1. Bring/have your own mouthpiece/mallets for camp & year.
2. If you need to check out a school instrument, including percussion, bring the form attached with signatures to allow us to start the checkout process and get them playing.
3. Bring a water jug for camp. Each person gets one as part of their dues, but not until after camp.
4. Bring your own lunch. Students are not allowed to leave campus for any reason during camp days.
5. Bring a towel for stretch and PT to protect against the pavement.
6. All music will be viewed digitally. You are encouraged to have a lyre or phone holder for your instrument. They can be found at the following web address:

7. Every student needs a solid black 3-ring binder for the music, course pack, and any additional items. Plan to have music printed prior to the arrival to camp, whenever possible. Please prepare to be out in the sun. Use plenty of sunscreen, and drink lots of water. Athletic shoes and socks are required for rehearsals along with appropriate attire. *If it is not proper dress code for school, it is not acceptable at band rehearsal.* Light-colored clothing is best. Wear a hat and/or sunglasses.

Winds and percussionists – begin working on your basic skills. Start buzzing, breaking in the reeds, and working up the rudiments. Guard, pull out the flags and start spinning! I need guard members to contact me as soon as possible to discuss show uniforms and sizing. Email me at
