MARCHING BAND AGREEMENT AND EXPECTATIONS

Each member of the ensemble must read and agree to the terms as follows in order to participate. In return, the Campbell Marching Band and its staff will provide all necessary instruction, materials, travel, and experiences in order to insure a safe, productive, and rewarding experience.

PLEASE RETURN ALL THE NECESSARY ATTACHED FORMS WITH YOUR \$250 DEPOSIT BY MAY 18, 2020. THE \$250 DEPOSIT MUST BE RECEIVED TO ENSURE A SPOT FOR THE 2020 MARCHING SEASON.

ATTENDANCE POLICY:

1. All marching band members must also be enrolled in a concert ensemble.
2. A full rehearsal and performance calendar is attached.
3. All rehearsals and performances are MANDATORY.
4. Students who must miss a rehearsal must report their absence via <http://www.campbellband.org>
5. Absences must be reported 2 DAYS in advance.
6. Last-minute absences such as illness or family emergency should be reported to Mr. DeWinter within a reasonable time frame.
7. If you are absent from school, please bring Mr. DeWinter a copy of the attendance note the day you return.
8. Absences from performances will not be permitted except in the most extenuating circumstances which are determined on a case by case basis.
9. Rehearsals begin on time and will end on time. *The start/end time of rehearsals DOES NOT include travel time or setup and stowing of equipment.* Expect your student to take 10-15 minutes to prepare on either side of rehearsal time.
10. **Being Tardy to rehearsal is only permitted for tutoring with a note from their teacher.** Club meetings are not excused. You must communicate with your club sponsor your obligations to the ensemble.

ATTENDANCE CONSEQUENCES:

1. Absences will be EXCUSED or UNEXCUSED at the discretion of the directors. A general rule to follow is that if CCSD will excuse it, so will we.
2. ANY UNEXCUSED ABSENCE during the week of the performance WILL result in the student in question being sidelined for the upcoming performance.
3. After August 1st - THREE unexcused absences in the course of the result will result in removal from the ensemble.
4. If you are sidelined, you must still attend the performance IN UNIFORM.
5. Any instance of ISS or OSS will be considered UNEXCUSED. You may not attend rehearsal if you are suspended.
6. Unexcused tardies will be made up prior to or after rehearsal BEFORE the following performance.

- Equipment truck unload (3 people) – unload box truck when it arrives from away games. Operate truck lift. Students also help.
- Concession Stand Manager – oversee concession stand operations
- Grill Master – cook hamburgers, hot dogs and fries for concession stands
- Parking Manager – take \$5 parking fee on Fowler Street 6pm to half time
- Morale Team – cheer and celebrate students as they return back to the band hall and after competitions, telling them they did a great job.

Band Volunteer Positions

Chaperones – (3 members needed)

Home Games – Volunteer arrival time 6:00pm

Prepare snacks, trash bag, three black drink carriers and two white coolers with blue lids with water bottles and ice prior to the game. Approximately 95 small water bottles and 95 large water bottles (or 3 cases of 80 small water bottles) and a few Diet Cokes for the band instructors. Take out to the stands using hand dolly.

Serve small water bottles after National Anthem.

Serve another water bottle and snacks after half time. All trash must be collected.

Away Games – Volunteer arrival time 4:30pm

Prepare snacks, trash bag, three black drink carriers, medical kit and two white coolers with blue lids with water bottles and ice prior to the game. Approximately 95 small water bottles and 95 large water bottles (or 3 cases of 80 small water bottles) and a few Diet Cokes for the band instructors. Load onto the buses using hand dolly. One chaperone per bus.

On the bus each chaperone is in charge of head count for each band member prior to leaving the campus and prior to leaving the away school. Any adult on the bus MUST have a background check form filled out.

Serve small water bottles after National Anthem

Serve another water bottle and snacks after half time. All trash must be collected.

Dinner – (3 members needed)

Home Games – Volunteer arrival time 3:45pm

Prepare lemonade in round cooler with orange lid. Gather plates, napkins, cups, serving utensils, gloves, and bring to the cafeteria. Get list of students who have paid to check off.

Set up food and serve students around 4:45pm.

Ensure all tables are cleaned and return paper products and food to the band room storage room and kitchen. Clean cooler and return to the storage room.

Away Games – Volunteer arrival time 3:45pm

Prepare lemonade in round cooler with orange lid. Gather plates, napkins, cups, serving utensils, gloves, and bring to the cafeteria.

Set up food and serve students around 4:15pm.

Ensure all tables are cleaned and return paper products and food to the band room storage room and kitchen. Clean cooler and return to the storage room.

Concessions Setup – (4 members needed)

Home Games only – Volunteer arrival time 4:00pm

Prepare snacks, candy, food items, trash bags, serving utensils, paper products, donation jug, serving trays, steno, oil for fries, volunteer list (supplies to create are in the concession stand), and any other items needed for that days menu and take to the concession stand and set up. Ensure price sheets available.

Prepare two large white coolers one with all water and one with soft drinks and Power Aid. Ice down and take to the concession stand. Prepare extra third cooler with all ice.

Bring generator, gas, white table, and tent to the concession stand and set up.

Petty cash CBBA member.

Concessions Sell/Breakdown – (8 members needed)

Home Games only – Volunteer arrival time 5:30pm

Sell goodies until the end of the game. We still have sales all the way until up until it is time to leave! After half time when the volunteers are unloading the equipment into the band room, have a concessions member restock any needed items (food/snacks/ice) while the room is unlocked. This will avoid having to run the key back and forth to the band instructors.

Break down the tent/tables/signs/food/etc. and return all remaining items to the storage room.

Take all remaining drinks out of the coolers and dispose of the ice. Wipe down the coolers and drinks and restock in the storage room.

Money brought to the band room and counted by two CBBA members at the end of the night.

Grill Master First Half – (2 members needed)

Home Games only – Volunteer arrival time 4:00pm

Get propane gas and prep, clean, set up the grill. Cook all foods for the first ½ of the game.

Grill Master Second Half – (2 members needed)

Home Games only – Volunteer arrival time Half Time

Cook all foods for the second ½ of the game. Clean grill and return propane gas.

Parking – (3 members needed)

Home Games only – Volunteer arrival time 5:00pm

Get petty cash (CBBA member), money holders, and two metal A-frame Parking signs from the band storage room. Set up one sign at the parking lot entrance and another sign just **before** the street leading to the Smyrna Elementary School. This allows folks to turn around if they don't want to pay for parking.

Start collecting at **5:30pm**.

Stop collecting at half-time and return signs and money holders to the band storage room. Money to be counted by two CBBA members.

Pit Crew – (6 members currently/9 members with sound equipment)

Home Games – Volunteer arrival time 7:30pm before half time

With approximately 3-4 minutes before half time walk down to the field. Once half time begins and the band starts to go onto the field move the 5 window props to just inside the white field line at the below markers:

home 35 yard line, home 42 yard line, 50 yard line, away 42 yard line, away 35 yard line)

Once the performance is complete move all equipment immediately off the field to the band room and the 5 window props into the semi. Make sure the truck door is securely shut and latched. Make sure the band room is locked!

Pit Crew – (6 members currently/9 members with sound equipment)

Away Games – Volunteer arrival time 7:30pm before half time at away school

With approximately 3-4 minutes before half time walk down to the field. Once half time begins and the band starts to go onto the field move the 5 window props to just inside the white field line at the below markers:

home 35 yard line, home 42 yard line, 50 yard line, away 42 yard line, away 35 yard line)

Once the performance is complete move all equipment immediately off the field to the band truck.

It is not mandatory for the volunteers to go back to the school to help unload the truck but help is always welcomed!!

Spirit Team – (As many people as possible!)

Home/Away Games – When the band comes off the field or busses after the game cheer as loud as possible!! Cow bells appreciated!!
